

## 2011-2012 KINDERGARTEN REGISTRATION

On March 1, 2011, Oak Grove School District will begin registration of children who will enter kindergarten in August 2011. Children born on or before December 2, 2006 may enroll in our kindergarten program.

PARENTS/GUARDIANS ARE REQUIRED TO PROVIDE THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION AT THE TIME OF REGISTRATION. (Please use this letter as a checklist as you gather the information.)

- \_\_\_ 1. Verification of age (one of the following):
  - a. Certified copy of a birth record
  - b. Original county recorder's verification of birth (hospital forms will not be accepted)
  - c. Passport
- \_\_\_ 2. Verification of address (one of the following):
  - a. Lease agreement, mortgage or property tax payment
  - b. Utility bill (phone, electricity, water, etc.)
  - c. Affidavit of residence – if you do not rent or own the property, but live with someone, the homeowner must come with you to the office with verification of his/her address (either “a” or “b”). You and the homeowner must sign an affidavit of residence witnessed by the office staff.
- \_\_\_ 3. Doctor's verification of month, and year of the following immunizations:
  - \_\_\_ a. **Poliomyelitis** (polio) 4 doses but 3 doses are acceptable if the last dose was given after the age of 4 years.
  - \_\_\_ b. **DPT** 5 doses but 4 doses are acceptable if the last dose was given after the age of 4 years
    - diphtheria
    - pertussis
    - tetanus
  - \_\_\_ c. **MMR** (2 doses) The first dose must be given on or after the first birthday. One of the doses must be MMR; the other dose may be any measles-containing vaccine.
    - Measles
    - Mumps
    - Rubella (Rubella)
  - \_\_\_ d. *Hepatitis B* (3 doses)
  - \_\_\_ e. **Varicella** (chicken pox) on or after first birthday.
  - \_\_\_ f. **Mantoux** (TST) skin test for tuberculosis is required in Santa Clara County. Written evidence to the school must include:
    - Date the Mantoux test was given
    - Date the Mantoux test was read (must be 48-72 hours after given)
    - Measurement of the induration in millimeters
    - Signature of physician or designeeThis Mantoux test must be administered within 18 months prior to school enrollment. Those with a history of a positive skin test must present a physician's statement indicating the date the student had a negative chest x-ray and that the student is free of communicable tuberculosis.
- \_\_\_ 4. Full physical examination (**completed after March 1, 2011**).
- \_\_\_ 5. Dental examination (**completed after August 1, 2010**).

**NOTE:** STATE LAW REQUIRES that each child have a full health examination within 18 months prior to entering first grade. District guidelines require that your child receive a full physical examination no earlier than six months before starting kindergarten (**after March 1, 2011**). A doctor's report form has been included with the registration materials. Most physicians prefer to do the physical exam when updating the immunizations.

Kindergarten registration will begin on **March 1, 2011**.

**Parents of kindergartners who wish to apply for a different school placement under the School Choice Policy may do so on February 1, 2011.** For further information contact the Oak Grove School District Choice Office, 227-8300, Ext. 208.
